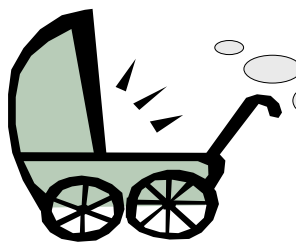

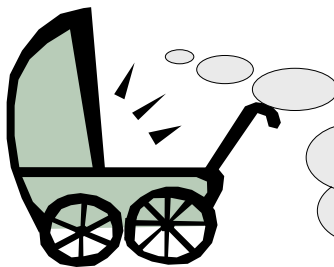

## **OXTED PRAM RACE INSTRUCTIONS – 9<sup>TH</sup> JULY 2010**

### **Before the night...**

1. Complete the attached form and hand in to The Crown Inn, Old Oxted no later than 10pm on Wednesday 7<sup>TH</sup> July.

**Note: if you miss this deadline, you will not be able to register on the night.**

2. Raise as much sponsorship as possible – we want all teams will raise loads of money. Remember, this event is all about raising money for local charities (as well as having a lot of fun!). Last year we supported many local causes including:
  - Pastens Childrens Home (for 5-19 year olds with behavioural challenges or a physical handicap)
  - Woodhouse Centre in Oxted (provides employment/companionship for elderly and disabled residents)
  - Master Park (for park improvement projects)
  - Oxted Chamber of Commerce (for improvements to the Christmas lights)
  - Oxted District Guide Association (to improve the Guide Hut)
  - Holland Sports AC (replacement of long jump runway)

Use the attached sponsor forms and hand in at least 50% of your sponsorship money or as much money as possible when you register before the race. All teams donating more than £100 on or before the night will be entered into a fantastic prize draw.

### **On the night....**

1. Be at **Master Park** at **6.00pm** for Registration and ensure you have the team name you put on your entry form, at least 50% of your sponsorship promise (all of it would be better!!) and proof of 18+ id (as you might be asked).
2. Parking will be suspended in both Master Park car parks, the Community Hall and along Church Lane - park elsewhere in the town and walk to the start.
3. The race will start at **7.15pm** (whatever the weather!). Under 18s will lead off first.

**Ensure you come to Master Park in Church Lane (nr. tennis courts)  
by 6.00pm.**

### **Race rules....**

1. Any entrants under 18 years old **MUST** be accompanied by an adult (18+) around the course.
2. Prams must have at least one wheel and a place to sit in/on. The only form of propulsion is pushing.
3. A minimum of two people form a team – one pushes/one sits, alternating at each stop (swap in between if you get tired).
4. Up to six people can enter as a team and the £10/£5 entry fee will be applicable to each person. (Due to safety reasons, teams of more than 6 will not be accepted this year – sorry!!)
5. Half pint of beer, spritzer or soft drink (under 18s only) to be drunk by each team member at each stop. 15-second time penalties will be noted at each stop where the drink is not finished or is spilt.
6. The correct route must be followed to avoid disqualification. If your pram collapses, carry it to the end.
7. Judges for fancy dress will be in attendance at the start of the race.
8. 8 prizes are awarded - fastest time for, Adult men, Adult women, Adult mixed and youth teams (with penalties), plus best adult and youth fancy dress and the team handing in the most sponsorship on the night. A subsequent prize will be presented to the team that raises the most sponsorship in total.
9. Follow marshal instructions – marshals are there for everyone's safety and to ensure the rules are followed.
10. The judge's decision is final and anyone not entering into the spirit of the event will be disqualified. Remember this is a fun event!
11. All teams must remove their prams after the race (and take responsibility for disposal if trashed!).
